- Attendance information can be found in the handbook. Students arriving to school late or leaving early must sign in/out with the office.



**FAFSA:** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is for any financial aid for college. Seniors applying, may start applying **December 31, 2023** using their 2022 tax return information. Before you can access the application, you will need a FSA ID. Please go to fafsa.ed.gov and click on "FSA ID" to get started. This is an ID and password that you will need to remember as long as you are a college student, because you and your parents will have to fill out a FAFSA every year. Therefore, put your ID/Password in a safe place - your tax packet is the perfect place! Once you have your ID and password, you are able to get started filling out the FAFSA at <u>Studentaid.gov</u>

**JUNIORS & SENIORS:** If you would like to go on a college visit please pick up the College Visit Form outside the High School Office. All Juniors or Seniors must complete the form prior to the proposed college visit. Check with the college prior to scheduling a visit to make sure they are allowing visitors on campus. The bottom portion of the form must be signed by a college official verifying the visit and turned into the office for it to be counted as an excused absence.

**The ACT** (American College Testing) Program assessment is a college entrance examination which reports capabilities in the areas of English, Math, Reading, and Science. An optional writing test is also available for an additional cost. This test battery is given at an ACT test center up to seven times a year on a national test date. There is a registration fee, and the test may be taken more than once. Those qualifying for Free and Reduced lunches are also eligible to take it two (2) times for no charge. If you qualify, stop by the counselor's office for a waiver. Students should begin taking the test no later than their junior year. ### Macon R-1 High School 2024 Summer Drivers Education Class

### **Class Requirements:**

- Mandatory 30 clock hours of classroom instruction
  - Drivers Ed classes will be from 8:00 am 3:30 pm, beginning Wednesday, May 22. The remaining classroom instruction days are May 23, 24, 28, and 29.
    - These first five days are mandatory and can not be made up.
  - After the five days of classroom instruction, students will sign up for driving and observation hours, which are in two hour windows. Starting at 7:30 am -9:30 am, 11:00 am 1:00 pm, 1:00-3:00 pm, and 3:00 pm -5:00 pm. The schedule is dependent on the time slots the student chooses. Students must be on time for their driving time slot. Failure to do so can result in failure of the class and of the \$200 scholarship reimbursement.
  - Bus transportation is only available the first five days of instruction. You must contact the transportation office at 660-385-2197, option 2 to sign up for transportation.
- 6 clock hours behind the wheel (scheduled with instructor)
- 12 clock hours as an observer in the driver education car (scheduled with instructor)
- Must have a permit or have an Original Birth Certificate and be eligible to obtain a permit by May 30, 2024.

### **Class Registration:**

Students will have the opportunity on a first come, first served basis giving priority to Macon High School age students who are closest to driving or pursuing their driving permit. This class is limited to the first 23 to sign up. **Registration will occur in the High School Counselor's Office (Room 156) beginning at 7:30 am until 8:00 a.m. on the dates as follows:** 

- 1. Wednesday, April 24 for ages 15 ½ 18 years old (As of June 1, 2024)
- 2. \* Thursday, April 25 for ages 15 15 ½ years old (As of June 1, 2024)
- **3.** \* <u>Friday, April 26</u> for ages 15 18 years old (As of June 1, 2024 for students outside of the Macon School District) \*If necessary (once 23 spots are filled, registration will be complete.)

Students have two options available for payment. Students will need to have two separate checks payable to Macon County R-1 <u>in hand</u> when registering for the drivers education class OR \$250 in cash. The \$200 check will be the <mark>deposit and the \$50 check will be the price of the class.</mark> *We do not accept credit/debit cards.* 

The \$200 check will not be cashed unless the student fails to complete the course. The \$50 check will be cashed on August 1, 2024. Macon R-1 is partnering with the Northeast Coalition For Roadway Safety again this year. The Coalition is going to provide a scholarship that will reimburse the school district \$200 per student upon successful completion of the course. Therefore, if your child successfully completes the Drivers Education Program, it will only cost you \$50. The \$200 deposit will be returned to you.

Successful completion of the course requires perfect attendance for the course, the student attending the ThinkFirst program assembly on Thursday, April 16 during the school day, and the parent and student attending a First Impact program on **Tuesday, May** 21, from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m. in the High School Cafeteria.

The student or parent must be physically present at the time of registration to enroll in the class and must have payment in hand. (*Registration via phone will NOT be accepted.*)



## 2024 MHS Summer School Student Guidelines for Credit Recovery

Summer School Begins June 4th - Sign Up in the Counselor's Office - Room 156

- 1. You must complete all required assignments and receive a passing grade on this work.
- 2. Students will have the opportunity to recover 1.0 credit
- 3. Summer school is a voluntary program. If there are discipline problems you will be sent home and receive no credit.

### **Classroom Expectations**

- 1. Be on time every day. Classes start at 8:00 a.m. each day, students should arrive a few minutes early. School will be dismissed at 3:30 each day.
- 2. Students MUST bring a CHARGED CHROMEBOOK.
- 3. Bring pencil and paper every day to class.
- 4. Students are not allowed to leave the school building at any time during the day.
- 5. Students are expected to be at school every day until they have finished the requirements to regain their credit. Students with more than 2 absences per session will not be granted credit.
- 6. If a student is late getting to class it will be counted as tardy. If you accumulate 3 tardies you will not earn credit. (Students and parents will be warned after the 2nd tardy about the potential of not attaining credit.) Classes begin at 8:00 a.m. each day. Any student that arrives more than 15 minutes late will be sent home on that day.
- 7. Prearranged absences will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- 8. Students will be required to follow the same dress code as prescribed by the Macon R-1 student handbook.
- 9. No profanity or rude comments will be tolerated.
- 10. No cell phones are to be used during class time. Students may use their cell phones during lunch.
- 11. Students will be expected to conduct themselves appropriately at all times.
- 12. Lunch: Will be offered in the elementary school cafeteria for free. Lunch times may vary.
